**AGREED ORDER ADMITTING DEFENDANT  
TO POST-CONVICTION BAIL PENDING APPEAL**

UPON AGREEMENT between the State of Florida and the Defendant, John Goodman, and pursuant to Section 903.132(1) of the Florida Statutes and Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.691(a), the Defendant's *Motion for Bond Pending Appeal And/Or The Outcome of His Motion For New Trial*, is hereby GRANTED. It is further

ORDERED that the Defendant meet the following conditions prior to release from the Palm Beach County Jail and/or the custody of the Palm Beach County Sheriff, to wit:

a) The Defendant, or persons acting on his behalf, shall post a bail in the amount of SEVEN MILLION (\$7,000,000) dollars.

b) The Defendant shall be fitted with an electronic monitoring devise (GPS) in connection with being placed under the supervision of House Arrest. It is further

ORDERED that while under house arrest, and while residing at his residence located at 3665 120<sup>th</sup> Avenue South, Wellington, Florida 33414, which is located on the premises of the International Polo Club (IPC) (3667 120<sup>th</sup> Avenue South), the Defendant shall be permitted to leave his residence

to go to his office, located in a separate building within the confines of the IPC grounds, for business purposes. It is further

ORDERED that the Defendant shall submit to drug and alcohol testing, to be administered randomly. The Defendant shall pay all costs of testing, and the results shall be reported to the Defendant's house arrest officer in a manner to be determined by that officer. It is further

ORDERED that at the Defendant's expense, a duly credentialed Palm Beach County law enforcement officer shall be and remain within 100 feet of the Defendant at all times, 24 hours per day, every day, unless and until Ordered to cease by this Court. It is further

ORDERED that in the pending State of Delaware case of IN THE MATTER OF: THE TWO TRUSTS CREATED PURSUANT TO THE AGREEMENT DATED APRIL 29, 1991, KNOWN AS THE JBG CHILDREN'S 1991 TRUST AGREEMENT, C.A. No. 5894-VCP, should Heather Anne Hutchins be adjudged a recognized beneficiary to the JBG Children's Trust, the matter of the Defendant's post-conviction bail shall be brought back before this Court, by the State of Florida, for the purpose of reviewing whether the result materially changes circumstances affecting the security measures imposed under this Order to ensure the Defendant's continued presence in Palm Beach County. The Defendant shall also cause the Certificate of Service to include the names of Laura Laurie, Esq. and Sherri Collins, Esq. 401 North Dixie Hwy., West Palm Beach, FL 33401, in the pending Delaware litigation. It is further


ORDERED that while the Defendant may conduct his business affairs, he shall not participate in any business related social events, including attending polo matches, charity events, membership events, fundraising events, parties or other private events held on the IPC property. The Defendant is permitted to have family members, which includes Heather Hutchins, visit with him at his residence. The Defendant is also permitted to be visited at his residence by up to two

friends at a time. All such family and friend visits shall be confined to the Defendant's residence.

It is

ORDERED that the Defendant shall be permitted to travel away from his residence, and outside Palm Beach County, as necessary, and after giving reasonable notice to his house arrest officer, for purposes of meetings with his attorneys and for Doctors' appointments. However, the Defendant shall be accompanied by a duly credentialed Palm Beach County police officer for all such travel.
