AGREED ORDER RE: STATE INSPECTION OF BENTLEY

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court upon the Agreement of the State and the Defense that State experts may conduct an inspection/examination of the Bentley automobile as follows:

1. The experts will bring (compatible with this model Bentley), all needed hand tools, 3-D scanner, Digital Force Gauge, electrical power supply and volt ohm meter, and photography/videography equipment to the inspection and will do the following:
2. Perform a thorough physical inspection of the vehicle, including electronic measurements, manual manipulation and photographing/videoing of the throttle body(ies), including all internal parts (butterfly valve(s)), butterfly valve shaft(s), position sensors, rotational motors, electrical plugs/connectors, and the plastic cover over the electronics on the throttle body.
3. Perform a thorough physical inspection, manual manipulation and photographing/videoing of the vehicle's brake system.
4. Take measurements of the exterior and interior of the vehicle.

5. During the State's expert's inspection of the Bentley, the following shall not be permitted:
- a. Removal of any part or component of the vehicle;
 - b. Replacement of any part or component of the vehicle;
 - c. Connection or disconnection of any part or component of the vehicle, with the following exceptions:
 - i. The State's expert may remove and replace the black covers to the throttle bodies, and
 - ii. The State's expert may disconnect and reconnect the electrical plug-in to the throttle body.
 - d. Installation or utilization of any electronic control module (ECM's) or electronic control units (ECU's), or their equivalents.
6. It is further, stipulated and agreed the State shall video this examination/inspection and a copy of said video will be provided to the Defense.
7. A representative of the Defense is permitted to be present during the examination. The parties shall coordinate the scheduling of the inspection to ensure that the Defense representative is present for the inspection.
